Dear Parents,

Welcome back to the final term of our school year. This newsletter will tell you about all of the exciting events we have going on this term.

Sun Safety

Hopefully we will have some good weather this half term. Can we please remind you that if it is a hot day you should provide a sunhat and sun cream in a named bottle. Staff cannot apply sun cream to children so it would be useful if this was also applied before the start of the school day.

Attendance

Our whole school attendance is still very good; 96.9%. This year for, the first time, we have issued fixed term penalties to parents who have taken their children on holiday in term time. We really do not want to have to take this action so please help us by not booking holidays in term time. Please be aware that the penalty is not payable to the school, the penalty cost goes directly to the Local Authority.

Building Update

The work on our new kitchen will begin on June 22nd 2015 to enable us to serve meals, freshly prepared on site, from September 2015.

The work on the Quad, now to be named "Claudia's Garden", has begun and we are hoping that children will be able to enjoy this new learning area before the end of this academic year.

Our children whose parents work in HM Armed Forces have designed a reflective garden that will also be installed this term. This will be a quiet place for any child to sit, reflect, think or pray when they need some time on their own.

Finally, as part of our on-going refurbishment of the school building the Robins class, cloakroom and toilet area will be fully refurbished this summer.

I am sure you will agree that all of the above will continue to improve the environment for our wonderful children and staff.

Peace Window

Due to a successful bid to the Diocese of Lincoln, we will be installing a stained glass peace window in the school hall. Each class in school will get to give their ideas to the artist we have commissioned to do the work, then a group of children will get the opportunity to create the window. We see this as a whole community project and are working with the Royal British Legion. Please let us know if you have any good ideas or anything you would like to see incorporated into the design.

Key Stage Two Summer Production

Due to the building work that will be going on in school to accommodate our new kitchen we will hold our Key Stage Two production in the Festival Hall this year. As we previously notified you the performances are on the following dates.

If the weather is bad on this day we will try again on Tuesday 16th June 2015. Friends of the school have kindly agreed to sell refreshments on this day; thank you to them for that.

Keeping your children safe online

As we do every year, we have booked a computing consultant to come in and do a short presentation to parents about how to keep children safe online. This year this will be at 5.00 p.m on Tuesday 9th June 2015. Parents who have attended this in the past have told us how helpful this was to explain the risks of new technology and how to keep children safe. Things that will be covered include grooming, filters and use of social networking such as Twitter, Instagram and Facebook. As this information is so important we will provide childcare to help parents to attend. Staffing

Next year, after a successful year here at Market Rasen, Mrs Watson will return to Nettleton. We thank her for all of the work she has done here with us. I am sad to say that Miss Cable will be leaving us at the end of this year as she is going travelling around the world. We will be very sorry to lose Miss Cable who has done a wonderful job since joining us.

I am really pleased to say that Mr Butson will be staying with us next year. Due to our high pupil numbers in Key Stage Two we are opening another class next year and Mr Mullen, a teacher from Nettleton Community Primary School, will be joining us. We have also employed Mrs Jessica Gibson who is currently working at Welbourne Primary School. Finally, we have employed Mrs Rebecca Edwards as our new intervention teacher to replace Miss Cable.
