- Easter School runs from Monday 8<sup>th</sup> April to Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> April.
- School hours for those days are 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Staff will be Mr. Kennedy, Mr Mullen and Miss Entwistle, so children will be well supervised at all times.
- We will open the gates at the front of school to let children in at 8:55 a.m., and we'll release them at 3:00 p.m. at the front of school.
- Children **do not** have to wear school uniform, but should wear suitable, comfortable clothing. In the afternoons, we will be doing different activities including games / P.E., so trainers are a good idea.
- Children should bring a packed lunch and a water bottle daily. They can also bring a snack for morning break.

On Thursday 11<sup>th</sup>, we will complete some work in school before leaving for our trip to Cleethorpes. The bus will depart Market Rasen at 10:30 a.m., and we will go to MacDonald's followed by the cinema (we'll be watching the new Kung Fu Panda movie, which is a PG certificate). This trip is completely funded by the school. Children do not need to bring any money as there won't be the opportunity to spend it in Cleethorpes, due to the tight schedule. We intend to be back at Market Rasen by **3:00 p.m.**, and we'll let you know of any changes if they occur. We will post updates on the day on Twitter, including of any delays to the bus back to school.

We will ask the children before the Easter holidays what they would like to order at MacDonald's, and we're aware of dietary requirements from the form you completed.
